10. Nils Gustaf Andersson Hall (farmors far)

* 1858-01-21 Hasselbol, Alsters parish, Värmland.

In 1874 he started working as a farmhand for the farmer Gustaf Olsson in Skacklerud, Alsters parish. There he met the maid Sofia Andersdotter and he became the father of her daughter named Emma Karolina (No 11). By the time he was 17 and Sofia 31 years old. They never married.

He had the job as a farmhand for Gustaf Olsson until November 5 1876 when he moved on to Nedre Ulleruds parish. Before that, on September 28 1876, he had been accepted to become a soldier.

He stayed a very short time in Nedre Ulleruds parish and returned to Alsters parish and the soldier's cottage No 87 in Hasselbol in December 5 1876. That cottage was the house where he was born and also where his father before him was the soldier. His parents still lived there and he now he had to take care of the too.

In 1884 he married the maid Maria Pettersdotter and they had a daughter, Nanny Maria, in 1887.

They moved from the soldier's cottage No 87 Hasselbol on November 9 1889 to Grava parish in Värmland. By that time he was no longer a soldier.

In Grava parish he and his family moved in to the farm Öjenäs. He still used Hall as a family name. In Öjenäs he is said first to be a farmer then a worker.

In 1890 his wife died and he moved on to Södra Skived with his children. There he was a worker.

On March 10 1894 he and his daughter emigrated to North America, but they returned home again to Södra Skived in March 3 1895.

From Södra Skived they moved to Karlstads Landsförsamling on November 13 1898.

He married for the second time on November 19 1898, to Karolina Skog Hellström.

In 1901 he and his daughter changed family name to **Haglund**.

The family moved to the farm Busterud in Östra Fågelviks parish on November 22 1902 and back to Karlstads Landsförsamling and the house Rudsberg (p. 2465) on November 12 1903. (Stadsarbetare) (p. 2697)

They moved in 1904 on to the house "Erikstad 4" where they lived as tenants.

In 1905 his second wife died and in 1906 he and the daughter moved to the house "Eriksstad 7" i Karlstad. There he became betrothed to the widow Emma Gustafsson who also was the owner of Eriksstad 7. They never married and in 1907 he alone moved on to the house "Eriksstad 10" in Karlstad. In Eriksstad 10 (p.2348) he is noted as the owner.

He died on October 12 1938 in Nedre Ulleruds parish. He lived in Karlstad but died in Nedre Ullerud. Where in Nedre Ullerud is not known.
