14. Jonas Sander Andreasson (mormors far)

* 1847-02-08 Byagård, Annerstad, Ljungby, Kronoberg, Sweden.

Jonas Anders Andreasson born 8 Feb 1847 was born in Annerstad, Kronoberg, Sweden to a Andreas Månsson and Stina Carlsdotter.

He grew up with his parents in Annerstads parish. In 1862 he left home.

In 1871 he was living in Krokegatsroten in the city of Laholm, Halland, Sweden.

The same year, in 1871-12-10, he married Johanna Beata Pettersson (No 15) who lived in Halmstad, Halland, Sweden. She had moved in to Halmstad from Laholm earlier the same year. The following year he moved to his wife in Halmstad at the address "Söder No 10 Peterslund".

They lived there until 1873 and then moved to the address No 87 in Halmstad and in 1878 to the address No 53. There they lived until 1881 when they emigrated to North America on 1881-05-24.

1920 Rock Island Co., Illinois Census Lists the following: John S. Anderson, age 72, white, male, widowed, can read, write, and speak English. Both parents were born in Sweden. Immigrated in 1880 and Naturalized in 1885. Anna Hahn, daughter, age 44, white, female, married, can read, write, and speak English. Immigrated in 1880 and Naturalized in 1885.

Lived at 1013 17th Ave, Moline, Ill. Listed as Jonas Sander Anderson on 1st Covenant Church Register, Moline, Ill., page 22.

In USA he called himself John Sander Anderson
